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

Course Description

The MOMA Primary Care Roundup will focus on commonly seen illnesses from a variety of medical disciplines and have an osteopathic focus in treatment modalities. The primary care provider, as well as the specialist, will benefit from the breadth, depth, and practicality of the subjects discussed. This in-person and virtual didactic conference presents a rare opportunity for physicians to experience education on holistic care, OPP principles, and clinical training. The conference will also be available for 60 days after the live event for ondemand viewing.

Accreditation

The Montana Osteopathic Medical Association is accredited by the American Osteopathic Association to provide osteopathic continuing medical education for physicians. The Montana Osteopathic Medical Association designates this program for a maximum of 26.0 AOA Category 1-A credits and will report CME and specialty credits commensurate with the extent of the physician's participation in this activity.

The AAFP has reviewed the 2024 MOMA Primary Care Roundup, and deemed it acceptable for AAFP credit. Term of approval is from 8/9/2024 to 10/15/2024. Physicians should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

For Physician Assistants: AAPA accepts certificates of participation for educational activities certified for Category I credit from AOACCME, Prescribed credit from AAFP, and AMA PRA Category 1 Credit ™ from organizations accredited by ACCME or a recognized state medical society. As with other professions, physician assistants should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity.

For Nurse Practitioners and licensed nursing staff (RN, LPN, etc.): The Montana Board of Nursing allows continuing education credits that have been approved by "a professional organization that establishes criteria for continuing education in nursing, advanced nursing, medicine and other health care specialties." As with other professions, nursing professionals should claim only the credit commensurate with the extent of their participation in the activity
